- ***New* International Dues**

International dues received from Members and Associates of DUP are critical for the day-to-day operating costs of the association. Prices for our telephone service, internet, website, publications, accounting, bank charges, computer service, database development, software, office supplies, postage, shipping, and payroll have risen dramatically over the past several years. It has become necessary for us to raise the dues for our organization.

Beginning on May 1, 2024, our International dues will be raised to \$20.00 per year. We appreciate your support for this change which comes with the ongoing promise that all funds will continue to be spent with the utmost respect, care, and accountability.

- **Camp and Company Registrars:**

As you are aware, the membership dues will be increased by \$5 on the 1<sup>st</sup> of May 2024. The 2023 online Membership Application will reflect the increase also beginning 1<sup>st</sup> of May (\$5 registration fee and \$20 membership fee for a total of \$25). It is very important that applicants are directed to use the 2023 online Application where they will see the updated information. As you go over each new Application before signing it, please see that \$25 is sent with it.

- **The Ten-Year Camp Initiative**
